IMMIGRANT JUSTICE





THE PROBLEMS

- State law enforcement collaboration with ICE terrorizes immigrants, erodes their trust in state institutions, and makes communities less safe.
- Dreamers are forced to pay out-of-state tuition at public universities and colleges.

THE PEOPLE

- Undocumented Marylanders, their families, and our communities as a whole.
- Undocumented students who graduated from high school or college in Maryland.

THE LEGISLATION

- TRUST Act: Prevent law enforcement and corrections from cooperating with ICE on arrests and detentions.
- Override the veto of Strengthening the Dream Act: allow undocumented Marylanders to pay in-state tuition at state colleges and universities.

While legislative details may change, we expect immigrant justice to be an important issue for our partners in 2020.
