THE PROBLEM

Maryland laws have created a system that prevents the public from scrutinizing and holding accountable police officers who brutalize and mistreat people.

THE PEOPLE

THE LEGISLATION

- Remove legal barriers that prevent public access to records of police misconduct.
- Ensure public participation in holding police officers accountable for abuse and brutality.
